Treasurer's Report:

- Theresa distributed Treasurer's report. Scanned copy is attached to the email with these minutes. Current balance is \$12,065.38
- Income \$3784.86: Beach Blast; Spaghetti dinner; Fencing tournament; Cheryl O'Brien T-shirts.
- Expenses of \$695.06: Beach blast supplies, Spaghetti dinner supplies, Fencing tournament supplies.
 - Some receipts still outstanding so total event revenues not complete.

 - Ruth Holton will organize orders & distribution
 - Cost - TBD after Mark quotes but agreed on a minimum of \$12 and max of \$15
 - *AFTER MEEETING UPDATE: Mark quote \$4 per shirt so we're selling for \$12 each; 2 shirts for \$20.*
 - Need headcount of people coming so hospitality can be planned (Nancy & Cheryl coordinating)
 - Much discussion on how to collect donations. Ads for program seem difficult to handle. Group came to consensus to make donation "Thank You's" on the website and have kids collecting at the event.
