- Treasurer's Report - Submitted for the record and distributed. Additional \$45 in membership and \$26 for T shirt sales.
- Way & Means Report (Julie):
 - Holiday Fest - 12/6 from 12-4. 6 volunteers scheduled so far
 - Wing night fundraiser at Bleachers on Ridge Rd. on Sat., March 20. Cost is \$20 and we get \$8.
- Band Director's report (Matt; Meghan could not attend)
 - Madrigal dinner - huge thanks to all volunteers so far.
 - Need help for construction phase week of dinner. 4 people Mon & Tues during day (9-6) and Wed evening (6-9) and Fri evening (6-10). Also for teardown Monday. Margaret is coordinating.
 - Very few expenses so should be a good fundraiser.
 - Margaret suggested that ticket sales be put on morning announcements.
 - Holiday concert 2pm Sun 12/13. Mr. Schatt requested each family bring 1 dozen baked goods.
 - Candy sale \$250
 - Marching band ended with a good season.
 - Big thank you to Mary Dolansky for arranging tent for halftime snacks!
 - Big thank you to Margaret Bierman for coordinating all the volunteers!
 - Sounds of the Stadium concert collected approx. 175 cans/boxes of food and \$70 cash for Southern Hills Lend a Hand.
 - Mr. Schatt is reviewing the handbook for next year. Any suggestions and revisions should be submitted as soon as possible. He is planning to work on this over Christmas break.
 - New Uniforms - chose 4 basic designs at 10/19 meeting. Reviewed with band staff & resubmitted with revision comments to uniform companies. Plan to present these to band officers, juniors and administration separately to gauge interest in particular styles.
 - It was also noted that Girl's vocal dresses will need to be replaced soon. Cost is ~\$60 each.
 - Fruit sale ends this Friday with 12/14 delivery. Proceeds are going to the uniform fund. Expecting approx. \$2000 in profit and hoping for some last minute additions before Friday.

- Commissioned work for Mr. Gunlicks complete 11/30 and name is yet to be determined. Balance due is approx. \$3000.
 - Severance date is 1/24. Attire is tuxedos for boys and calf length skirts for girls. Order forms sent home last week for tickets - \$10 each.
 - 8 complimentary tickets - Ken & family (4); Mr. Howard (2) & Mr. Laurezi (2).
 - Instrument repairs have been done in house and hopefully will be good for remainder of this year.
