BAND:

- Marching band uniforms - \$2645 in personal donations have passed through my hands and an additional \$5000 has been pledged by Independence Kiwanis. Music Boosters has additional money set aside as well. Recommend moving forward with coats & hats for next year. Can discuss in December.
 - Fruit sale – money & orders due Fri 11/12. Order placed on Monday. Delivery 12/9 – same day Butter Braid order arrives. We must be very diligent this year when we pick up fruit. Some parents and students took whatever they “thought” they needed which left us with a lot of last minute arranging. Please make sure that an officer checks you off if you are coming to pick up fruit and butter braid.
 - ButterBraid orders due Fr 11/19.
- Sound of the Stadium
 - Thanks for assistance & support!
 - Raised \$102 and 387 canned goods for Southern Hills Lend-a-Hand. They were very appreciative of our donations. Items were dropped off at the Civic Center Mon 11/1.
- Upcoming events:
 - Holiday concert – all music dept students will bring bakery
 - Spaghetti dinner – best to set new date. Haven't been able to get copies of building permit...
 - Revue – details in Jan
 - CVC Honors Band – We've been nominated to host in April. More to come later.
 - Florida trip
 - Practice begins mid-February (very short)
 - Profits submitted to Indy Treasurer on Oct 14 for mailing to New Horizons. May have JUST BEEN SENT this past week. Keep checking on line at NHHT.com for updates. New Horizons can

always send refunds if overpay. Only 1 student is close to payment 3 and 4 being paid for. Likewise, Fruit Sale & ButterBraid may adjust totals in the end. 118 students and 5 chaperones (not including directors and staff) have committed to the trip to date. There will be a MANDATORY meeting for parents and their traveling student in March (check Music Dept schedule for exact date).

- Diane Niro presented us with a fantastic opportunity! Her family orthodontist, Dr White, offers a free orthodontic treatment to non-profit groups. We need to submit a proposal, which Marcia has drafted and ready for signatures. Diane said that Dr. White verbally agreed to donate to our group and be sure to mention Dianes's conversation with him in the cover letter.
 - Dr White usually recommends a silent auction but that may not be best for our Wing Night set up. It was agreed to sell \$10-20 raffle tickets. Looking for another big ticket item or 2 to pair up with this (TV, Ipod, ...).
 - Thanks so much to Diane for bringing us this opportunity.
 - Kathy proposed we recognize Dr White in some way (name on jacket?)
- Kathy reminded all present to keep looking for business type donations for Wing Night. She obtained a verbal commitment from a local grass cutting business to donate service package. Diane has a local cigar shop set to donate a basket.
- Diane suggested that we try to pre-publish a list of baskets to auction.
- Several people mentioned putting a dollar value for each basket.
- Looking for someone to donate raffle ticket printing (Vodraska does for AfterProm)
- Putting together 2 baskets for raffle at musical.
- Anna & Julie are handling concessions for musical.
- Still need some volunteers for basketball concessions 11/14 (7-3) and 11/21 (7-7)
 - Eileen will check with person handling football concessions – may be some Gatorade leftover we can sell.
 - Any leftovers from basketball can be used at Holiday Fest
- Nancy Flynn offered to coordinate Holiday Fest. Mary is working on volunteers.
- Set ups needed for musical
 - 2 cash boxes for tickets and 1 for concessions.
 - 4 people for tickets
 - Kathy Jones will contact Meghan on handling of money collected for tickets
 - Teri is going to handle flower sales. She spoke with Aldi manager and got a good price. She will buy for Friday and see how many are sold before buying for Sat.

- Suggested that we reserve a bouquet for kids to present Donna Harlan. It was noted that she is incredible in how meticulous and caring she is to make the show look very professional.
- Don will deliver 2 water coolers for backstage Friday. Someone else will need to refill for Sat show.
- Marcia has 3 butterbraids left from Sounds of the Stadium that she will bake for samples at intermission (and will get order forms from Meghan).

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NEW BUSINESS

- Boosters paid for an ad in the Oklahoma! Program (officers voted via email to approve)
- Jaszczaks offered to chair the Spaghetti Dinner again this year (last one ☺)
 - Date is set for 2/12 but now have a conflict with basketball game. Much discussion followed about alternative dates. This date was set for week before OMEA to give kids a practice venue.
 - The building permit is “missing” but the event is on the district calendar.
 - Alternate dates that could work – Feb 26 (but is after OMEA), Fri 2/11 (but there’s swim team sectionals). Could do 2/12 from 4-7pm but then Jaszczaks would need a shopper since they cannot take 2 days off work.
 - Need to resolve date before the weekend to get posted in Spotlight.
 - Ticket price needs to be raised – cost of food has gone up considerably and we’ve not adjusted. Profit was lower last year. Agreed to go from \$8 to \$10 for adults; \$5 to \$6 for kids.
 - We could work around basketball conflict by entering through side door near Media Center – actually worked well doing that last year.
 - When Matt returns to school (he has been ill), Marcia will meet with him and resolve the date.
