- Pop & Water Booth (Jim Halamek) – The booth ran smoothly and profit was slightly better than last year, perhaps due to the better location of the water booth and the warm weather. We sold out 50 cases of water. The booth was busy during the parade but fewer students are needed in the water booth.
- Shaved Ice (Mary Dolansky) – Ice sold out. One student in the ice booth seemed like the right number.
- Pretzel Booth (Rhonda DeFini) – Student volunteers were helpful and the booth ran smoothly. Pretzels and water were being sold in the beer tent. Mary Dolansky discussed with the City when booths were selling non-approved items.
- Ticket Booths (Mary Dolansky) – Profit slightly more than last year.

Photo Buttons (Mary Dolansky)

- Sales were \$384. Expenses not yet known. Supplies to make the buttons are being donated by Chris Grande.

Summer Community Concerts (Mary Dolansky)

- Profit more than last year with accepting donations rather than pricing and selling the bakery.
- Thank you to Candy Fogg for allowing the Boosters the use of her freezer.

Football Refreshments (Mary Dolansky)

- Planning is in process. Open for suggestions for meals that do not require electricity to heat.
- All volunteer spaces were filled during sign ups at informational meeting in June.
