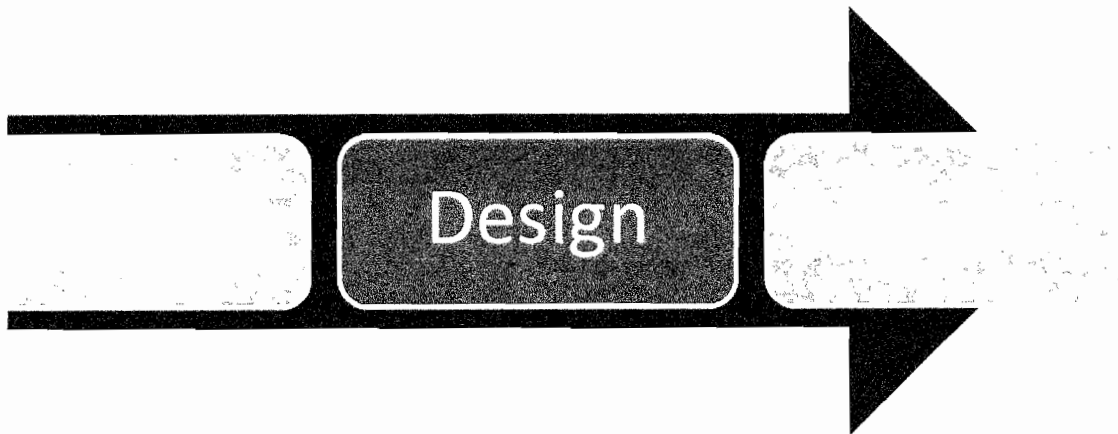


Independence High School Marching Band Marching Uniform Planning Process

Step 2: Design (2010)

- Design Committee – 7 Members
 - 2 Directors = Band Director + Flag Line Adviser
 - 2 Parent Members = Minimum One (1) IHS Music Booster Officer
 - 2 Student Members = Minimum One (1) Elected Band Officer
 - 1 Administration Member = High School Principal
- Suggested Implementation:
 - Purchase Only What We Need for August, 2012
 - Approx. 100 Uniforms (or less) @ \$600.00 = \$60,000
 - Supplement in 2013 With Additional Uniforms @ \$600.00

* Good/Bad News! Our student enrollment in the district is declining steadily which means fewer uniforms to purchase in 2012!

Proposed Timeline:

2009-2010 – Uniform Fundraising

2010-2011 – Florida Trip Fundraising, Design Uniforms

2011-2012 – Uniform Fundraising, Order Uniforms

August, 2012 – Debut Uniforms

Considerations:

- Working on this large of a project will afford the opportunity to get more parents involved and strengthen our Boosters organization for the future, as well as give us a much needed mission!
- Needs to be a transparent and visible project in the community (e.g., large sign in the center of town, web presence).
- Find ways to motivate students, as the debut of new uniforms can give the audience chills of excitement!
- Encourage “pay-it-forward” mentality.
- Can it be done sooner? We will find out! (Every large project demands a set goal to strive for.)

Objectives for Fall 2009:

- ✓ **Brainstorm and compile a list of possible fundraisers and specific targets for capital appeal.**
- ✓ **Save/Apportion monies, as appropriate.**
- ✓ Schatt = Talk to other area directors about process.
- ✓ Schatt = Will meet with competing uniform companies to learn more about the process from their side of the table.

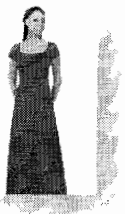
