Athletic Development Corporation (ADC) presentation

- One hour sales presentation of their training system to enhance athletic performance. Package consists of Vibration Platforms, Treadmills and software that tailors training programs for the individual. System can be incorporated into existing weight room. Final costs were not specified, but would include the initial equipment purchase plus an annual fee of \$100 per participant.
