Treasurer's report: Total of \$11,780.36 in Booster's account. All bills are paid to date. Sports teams still have \$5,000 in their account to be used.

Athletic Dept. News – Winter Sports Awards Banquet went well considering the weather. Additions to coaching staff for Spring Sports: Jim Crooks – baseball; Paul Molnar & Hannah Stretar – Softball; Kevin Clymer – Track. A number of teams in the conference have lost Freshman and JV teams. Spring sport pictures will be held tomorrow, March 20. Dan Baran and Patrick Wisnieski made the East/West All-Star basketball game. A request was made to purchase an ad to the All-Star program. Decision was made to purchase a ½ page ad with no picture for \$50. The HUDL Program was brought up. This program allows member sports teams to submit game tapes, and view tapes from other members. We currently have a \$1,600 package. Football portion has already been paid for. Request was made for the Boosters to pick up the rest of the cost. This is being tabled until April meeting, at which the 2014-2015 budget will be presented. New Boy's Soccer coach is Ryan MacRaild. New Football coach is Jim Wotowiec, assuming approval by the school board. Renee Roche Run will be April 5. Boosters donated \$250 to the race.

New Business - Walk-around is tentatively scheduled for Tues., May 20. Senior Athlete Awards – Each coach will be allowed to pick one Senior from the sport that they coached. From there, the candidates will be voted on by all the head coaches, and Booster's board. One male and one female will each be awarded the Outstanding Senior Athlete Award.
