

Athletic Boosters Meeting
April 2014 - Ron Bernstein

Weds., April 23, 2014 – Regular Meeting

Regular meeting began at 7:07, with the following attendees: Lisa Kemenyes, Kathy Jones, Tim Skoczen, Ron Bernstein, Mark Massey, Mark Suhay, Rick Dolejs.

Minutes from the March 2014 meeting were read and accepted.

*Treasurer's report: Total of \$10,243.12 in Booster's account. All bills are paid to date. Sports teams still have \$5,000 in their account to be used. Profit from the Solon Cage Classic won't be known for about 2-3 weeks due to the fact that all receipts are still be compiled from all the venues through the administrator of the tournament. Estimated profit is comparable to last year.

* Solon Cage Classic went well. Only a few small issues. Next year a notice will be on the tournament website not to bring in outside food. One time clock went down and had to wait for a replacement clock to be set up. There were no issues for police. There was a need for a custodian to cover the Field House during the whole tournament. There was no custodian on duty at the Field House on Sunday. Complaints that Hawken was double charging for admission fees after the guests had already paid at another venue.

*There are no Coach Requests at this time.

***Athletic Dept. News** – The baseball/softball teams have played a number of games to date, in large part because the city has been able to get the fields prepped. A number of teams have not gotten in as many of their games yet. Girls Track is now competing in Division II due to the fact they have more numbers of girls on the team. A proposal was offered by Athletic Performance, to set up a conditioning program for all Indy student athletes. This is regarding the presentation by Megan Osysko & Brian Lebo from the February 2014 meeting. Cost for initial program would be \$4,800/yr. This would include all sports team programs. An additional charge of \$1,200 would be for the Speed & Agility Training. This is being tabled until the May meeting, and until we get feedback from the coaches. The Huddle Program offers team to accept and exchange game tapes between schools, and can be used for recruiting by the players. Total amount would be \$1,600. That would take into effect the possibility of all teams using the program. Currently football and boys/girls basketball uses this program. The \$1,600 will be added to the 2014-15 budget in the chance that the program is voted on to accept.

***New Business** - Walk-around is tentatively scheduled for Tues., May 20. Boosters will provide pizza and pop for those participating. Senior Athlete Awards – Each coach will be allowed to pick one Senior from the sport that they coached. From there, the candidates will be voted on by all the head coaches, and Booster's board. One male and one female will each be awarded the Outstanding Senior Athlete Award. Mark Massey will handle getting a trophy for the award. A cash award of \$100 will also be given by the Boosters. Presentation will take place at Senior Awards Day. Boosters will run (administer) the IPS apparel sale next year. Sale of the water damaged clothing from the Booster Stand will take place at the 'Farewell to the Field' party, Friday May 30, 6-9 PM. The election of officers for the Boosters, for the school year 2014-15 will take place at the May meeting.
